GREEN CHOICE

We offer our guests a Green Choice that allows guests to opt out of housekeeping services with a door hanger and receive a 5-euro voucher slipped under the door for the hotel restaurant, anna.

AVOIDING PLASTIC BOTTLES

To promote waste reduction and avoiding the use of single-use plastic, we have taken the initiative of providing glass bottles from Aqualex in every room. These bottles can be conveniently refilled at the filtered water station situated in the lift landings. Whether you prefer still or sparkling water, you can enjoy it without contributing to plastic waste.

CALL IF FORGOTTEN

We encourage guests to call for essentials, such as toothbrushes, instead of automatically providing them in each room. This approach helps us reduce unnecessary waste and contribute to responsible consumption practices.

WATER-SAVING FIXTURE

We have installed water-saving toilets and shower heads, ensuring optimal water efficiency without compromising your comfort. These fixtures help us reduce water consumption, contributing to a sustainable and responsible approach to hospitality.

CHEMICALS

THE BUILDING

Dating back to the late 1960s, the building was masterminded by architect Léon Stynen and has grown into one of Antwerp's iconic structures, prominently visible from the Ring Road. Crowne Plaza Antwerp, renowned as the city's primary destination for meetings and conferences, offers 262 well-appointed rooms and 14 versatile meeting spaces. Its advantageous position grants direct access to the Antwerp ring road, a direct shuttle service to Brussels Airport, and close proximity to the historic heart of

Antwerp.

Our hotel also holds a BREEAM certification (Building Research Establishment Environmental Assessment Method).

This widely used and internationally recognized certification evaluates our building's environmental performance and sustainability. We meet high standards in areas such as energy efficiency, water usage, materials, and waste management, further reinforcing our commitment to sustainability.
